## **Applications for Sixth Form Entry**

Young men and young women are admitted to the Lower Sixth Form to pursue a two-year course to Advanced level. A *Guide to Sixth Form Courses* outlines the many options and opportunities that are available and can be forwarded upon request.

The criteria for admission are:

- satisfactory reference from the applicant's present school (we can delay our request for this in certain circumstances);
- demonstrating in a range of interviews the ability and enthusiasm necessary for success at Advanced level;
- **a minimum of 20 GCSE points** (A\* = 4, A = 3, B = 2, C = 1) **including As and Bs** in the applicant's chosen subjects at AS/A2. If Dual Award Science is taken at GCSE, and the candidate wishes to take separate sciences at AS/A2, an A grade is required.

The main Open Day is Saturday 1 October 2011 between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. with Sixth Form Open Evening taking place on Wednesday, 22 February 2012 at 6.30 pm.

Sixth Form Open House will take place on Wednesday, 7 March 2012 between 8:45 p.m. and 12.45pm. Please contact Mrs Hewitt on 01274 553702 for further details.

The Sixth Form interviews will take place on Wednesday, 14 March 2012.

In order to start the procedure for Sixth Form entry applicants need complete and return the registration form contained in the Additional Information and Forms folder (forwarded upon request). An application form will then be sent for completion and return, with the applicant's mock GCSE grades. Following receipt of the completed application form a letter will be sent giving the date and times of interviews on 14 March.
