

# Drummond Studentship Funding 2020-21

The James and Eliza Drummond Studentship Trust, administered by the Old Bradfordians' Club (London) Ltd, provides funding to Old Bradfordians pursuing any special studies at university or on a vocational course. This can include research and other studies necessary for the applicant's career, which are likely to do honour to the School and to the applicant. The awards committee tries to keep the definition of 'special studies' as broad as possible, but it tends to be easier for a postgraduate or vocational course to exhibit the right characteristics.

An award of up to £1500 is possible, with additional special awards at the discretion of the London club also being made in recent years, not least to support a specific travel need or piece of equipment associated with your studies.

Former successful recipients of the award have gone on to be successful Actors, Oncologists, Architects, Teachers and Opera Singers.

Applicants must have been a pupil of Bradford Grammar School (BGS) for a minimum of two school years.

The studentships are awarded for a period of one year but may, at the discretion of the judging committee, be renewed for further periods (not exceeding three years in total).
