Pathways into Sixth Form

We have three pathways into Year 12 at Bradford Grammar School:

1. Three A Levels + an EPQ

Those students wanting to study three A Level subjects will take them through to examination in Year 13 and, in addition, complete the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) in Year 12. This highly regarded qualification allows students to develop the skills they will need to become successful undergraduates, adds breadth to the curriculum and provides an excellent basis for a section of the personal statement on the UCAS application.

2. Three A Levels and one AS Level

Some BGS departments offer the opportunity to take the AS Level exam after one year's study, ie at the end of Year 12. For those want to study an AS Level in addition to three A Level subjects, you will need to indicate which subject you would like to study for AS on the options form. After you have taken the AS exam towards the end of Year 12, you will discontinue the subject.

3. Four A Levels

If you would like to study four A Level subjects, you should tick four subjects (in the A Level column) on the options form. Please note, if you would like to do Mathematics and Further Mathematics, we expect you to study two further subjects to full A Level, and you should therefore choose this pathway.

All students have ample time during the school day to take full advantage of an extensive range of co-curricular opportunities and are actively encouraged to do so.
